Make a routine for your child to watch TV. Let your child watch some entertaining and educational TV shows such as Discovery Kids, Animal Planet so that he/she does not watch TV as a pastime.

Let your child watch movies like Jungle Book, Baby's Day Out, Ice Age, Home Alone, etc.

- Read bed time stories to your child. This will help in improving vocabulary and imagination.
- Help your child to learn simple sentences:
 - May I use the washroom.
 - May I drink water.
 - I have finished my lunch.
 - He/she is bothering me.
 - May I fill my water bottle.
 - I have brought my notebook.

- Help your child to introduce oneself.

EMOTIONAL AND SOCIAL

Encourage your child to take care of personal hygiene by inculcating following habits: -

- Covering his/her nose/ mouth while sneezing or coughing.
- Avoid licking his/her fingers.
- Avoid sharing towel/ handkerchief, brush and comb with other people.
- Trim nails every Sunday and hair every 4-5 weeks.
- Keep his/her hair lice free.
- Avoid touching his/her eyes, nose, mouth, ears with dirty hands.
- Washing hands frequently.

Help your child become caring human being by developing the following habits:

- Giving respect to his/her elders and loving his/her younger ones.
- Wishing and welcoming guests.
- Spending time with grandparents.
- Keeping the house clean.
- Helping you in arranging dining table. After eating, keeping his/her plate in the kitchen.

HAND AND FINGER SKILLS

- Encourage him/ her to open and fill water bottles, tiffin, hanging of school bag, wearing and removing shoes, folding of apron/ napkins.
- Encourage your child to comb hair.

COGNITIVE SKILLS

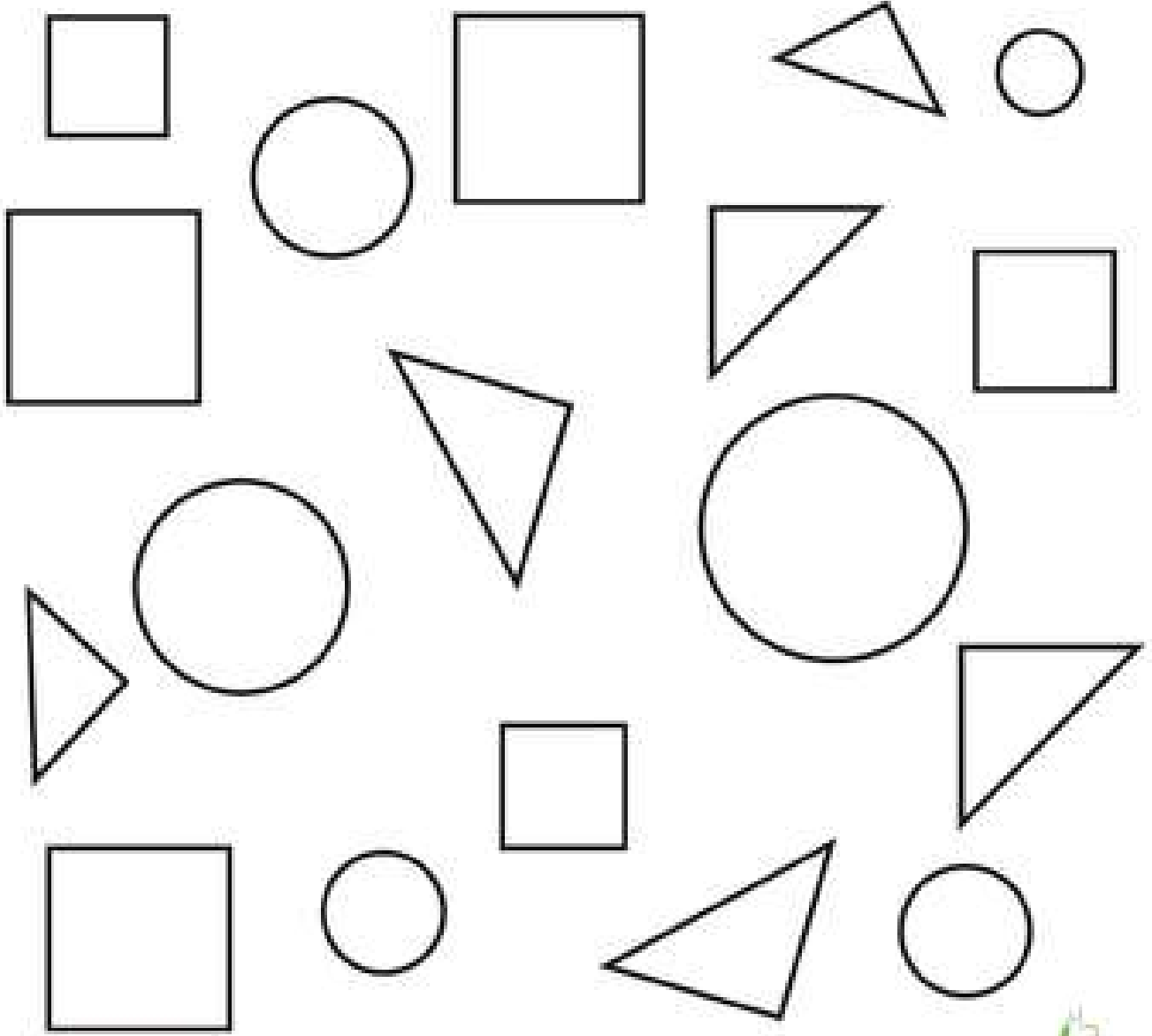
- Familiarize your child with secondary colours (green, purple, orange, brown). Kindly see the example given sheet no. 2-5

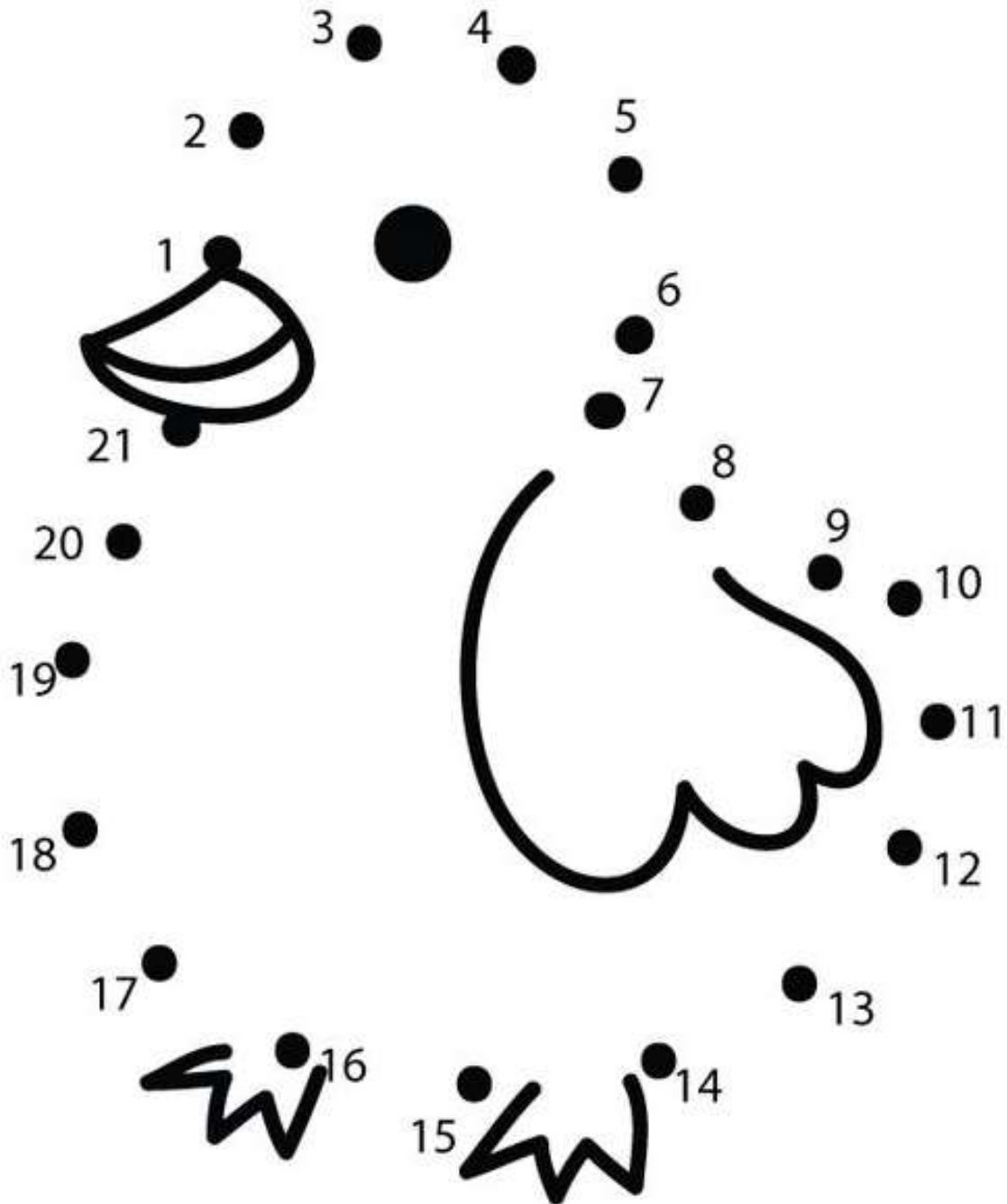
Colour the balloons with brown colour.

Help your child join the dots with help of a pencil and colour it.



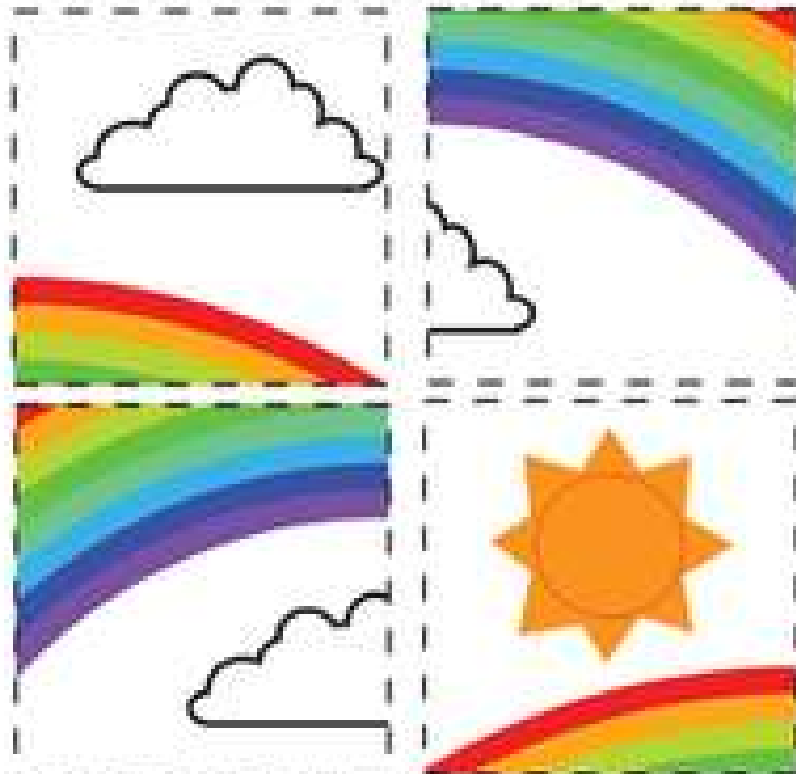
